While Cong promises to restore Old Pension Scheme, BJP relies on Modi's call for a double-engine govt

New Delhi: An aggressive BJP campaign to retain power and a strong counter-offensive by an upstart state unit of Congress that is banking on its promise to restore Old Pension Scheme, the issues of government jobs and Aajeevika have made the Himachal Pradesh elections highly interesting this time. The electorate will cast its vote on Saturday in a one-phase election.

The previous elections in Himachal Pradesh, which has an assembly of 68 seats, would not create much euphoria as they were held along with Gujarat, which hogged all the attention. The tradition in the hill state of voting out the incumbent was another danger. However, this time both BJP and Congress are fighting this election aggressively and are optimistic about their prospects.

Victory in the Mandi Lok Sabha byelection and three assembly seats has come as a shot in the arm for Congress. It is also hopeful of winning the ruling party has always been booted out since 1985. The passing away of senior Congress leader and former chief minister Virbhadra Singh in July 2020 has left the party leadership but there are also chances of this winning some sympathy for it, especially in the Shimla, Solan and Sirmaur belt.

Congress has promised restoration of the Old Pension Scheme which was discontinued in 2004. It has again gained a lot of traction in the state. Since the hill state industrialisation, government jobs, especially in the defence forces, are a prime attraction. OPSS has become the talking point in

this election and Congress has cited the example of Rajasthan and Chhattisgarh where it claims it has implemented the pension scheme.

BJP is banking mainly on the popularity of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his call for a "double-engine" government with the same party in power at the Centre and in the state for speedy growth and smooth delivery of central welfare schemes.

Chief Minister candidate, Senior Congress leader Purnima Verma, Purab Vash, Lakshmi Kaur, Lalit Vasoya, Prasad Dhillon, Anshu Dhillon have been nominated from their respective seats.

In a related development, former Union Minister and GPOC President Shri Virbhadra Singh is expected to return to Congress on Saturday. Virbhadra Singh's son Mahendresh Singh had returned to Congress after working in the private sector. It may be remembered that Virbhadra Singh had voted against the Congress candidate in the Rajya Sabha election in 2007 and eventually parted ways with it.


